R.C.G.A. Rules Govern Play

1. Out of Bounds defined by boundary fences and white stakes.
2. Lateral Water Hazards defined by red stakes on hole # 5, 7, 8 and 9.
3. Water Hazards defined by yellow stakes.
4. Ground Under Repair defined by white lines.
5. Free Relief from all artificially surfaced roads, paths, staked trees and 150 yd stones.
6. Yardages measured to the center of the green.

Dress Code and Etiquette

1. PLEASE rake bunkers, repair ball marks and replace divots.
2. Dress Code - traditional golf attire recommended. Only golf shoes and running shoes are acceptable. Metal Spikes Prohibited.
3. Pace of Play - approximately 2 hours. If necessary eliminate honors, hit when ready.
4. Power Carts - Keep away from tees and greens. Maximum two people per cart.
5. Retrieving golf balls from residences is strictly prohibited.

Ways To Play Without Delay On The Tee

- Play a realistic set of tees for your ability.
- Take two or three clubs with you to the tee.
- Watch errant shots carefully; line up your ball position so that it will be easier to find.

Through The Green

- Be committed to keeping pace with the group in front of you.
- Walk quickly, it's great exercise.
- Keep the time looking for balls to an absolute minimum.
- When using carts, drop off one player and proceed to the next ball.
- In the sand, the rake should be taken with you.
- Upon reaching the green, leave your bag or cart at the side of the green closest to the next tee.

On The Green

- The player whose ball is closest to the pin should tend the flagstick.
- Look over your putt while others are putting.
- Be ready to putt when it's your turn.
- The first player to finish should be ready to replace the flagstick.
- Leave the green immediately and mark your score on the next tee.

If you're ready, go ahead and hit.
Let's all have fun and play in a timely manner.
