### Regulations

1. All players must be registered at the Proshop before teeing off.
2. Proper dress required – no cutoffs, gym shorts, tank tops or halter tops allowed. Golf shoes or proper flat soft-soled shoes required (metal spikes will not be permitted). Shirts must be worn at all times.
3. Course Marshal/Starter – has the authority to control speed of play and enforce course regulations.
4. Each player must have their own set of clubs and bag.
5. All carts – power or pull, must be kept off the tee boxes and not taken closer than 30 feet from the greens. Maximum 2 riders per power cars.
6. Persons using these premises do so at their own risk.
7. All Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission regulations apply and are strictly enforced.
8. Remember the 4 R's:
  - Rake traps
  - Repair ball marks
  - Replace divots
  - Play Ready golf
9. Course maintenance staff have the right-of-way at all times.
10. All golfers are permitted on the course on the basis they maintain a reasonably close relationship to the group in front of them. Groups unable to keep pace will be asked to skip one hole by the course marshal.
11. All players and other persons at the golf club, or on the golf course, assume all risks of injury to themselves, damage and loss to property, and are liable for their acts to all other persons.
12. Any player violating these regulations may be asked to leave the facility.

**RULES OF PLAY**

1. R.C.G.A. rules govern all play except where local rules prevail.
2. Slow play will not be tolerated. 
3. Out of bounds - white stakes and fences bordering the golf course define out of bounds.
4. Water hazards - all water on course is considered lateral water hazard - red stakes.
5. Obstructions - all cart paths, sprinkler heads, control boxes, service roads, trees with stakes and/or ribbons, 150 yard markers and buildings in bounds - a drop within one club length from the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole, with no penalty.
6. Ground under repair - if your ball or stance has been hindered by G.U.R. proceed under Rule 25 - 1 free drop.

For your enjoyment, we recommend you play the designated tees.
