

KANANASKIS RULES OF PLAY



Rules of the **ROYAL CANADIAN GOLF ASSOCIATION** will govern all play EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES.

Beside tees and greens, **USE ONLY DESIGNATED ENTRANCES & EXITS AS PROVIDED.** CART PARKING IS PERMITTED ONLY ON PATHWAYS & PARKING AREAS.

RED STAKES — Should your ball enter a hazard marked by RED STAKES, (ie) #1 Lorette or #6 Kidd, and crosses the water into the trees/rough, YOUR NEXT SHOT SHOULD BE PLAYED FROM THE POINT OF ENTRY — 1 CLUB LENGTH FROM THE RED STAKES. (1 stroke penalty).

YELLOW STAKES — water hazard.

BALL RESTING ON CART PATH OR ROADWAY — may be lifted and dropped NOT nearer the hole. NO PENALTY.

BRIDGES OR COURSE EQUIPMENT THAT INTERFERE WITH STANCE OR SWING — ball may be lifted and dropped NOT nearer the hole. NO PENALTY.

PIN POSITIONS — are designated by FLAG COLOUR.

RED: front of green;

WHITE: middle of green;

BLUE: back of green.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Absolutely NO alcoholic beverages are allowed on the course. Players breaking this rule will be asked to leave the course immediately.

DOUBLE PAR SCORING — when your number of strokes has reached DOUBLE THE PAR ON ANY HOLE, PICKUP YOUR BALL and proceed to the next tee so that PLAYERS FOLLOWING ARE NOT HINDERED in their pace of play. (ie) par 4 (doubled) = 8 strokes.

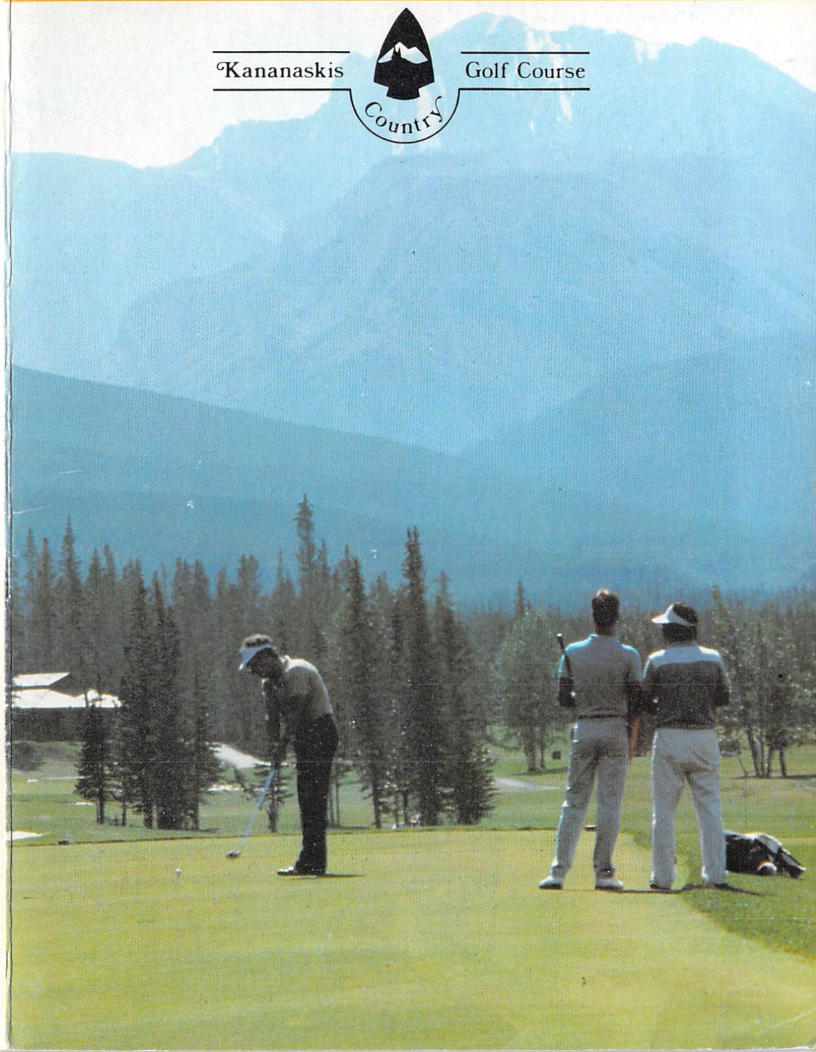
DRESS CODE IN EFFECT.
