

Rules and regulations of the Bear Mountain Golf & Country Club

R.C.G.A. rules govern play except where modified by local rules.

"Out of Bounds" shall be defined by white stakes. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies out of bounds.

"Lateral hazards" will be defined by red stakes or red lines. A ball is in a lateral water hazard when it lies in or any part of it touches the lateral water hazard.

"Water hazards" will be defined by yellow stakes or yellow lines. A ball is in a water hazard when it lies in or any part of it touches the water hazard. Stakes and lines defining the hazards are considered in the hazard and may be removed if interfering in the execution of a shot.

Local Rules

Safety: Due to ongoing activity all areas will be deemed a "Development Hazard" (i.e. rock hazards, fescue, development areas, woodlands, etc.) If your ball is at rest in this area, under penalty of one stroke, determine the point of entry and drop your ball allowing two club lengths from the point of entry in any direction, not nearer the hole. We request that you exercise extreme caution when entering these areas.

Natural Habitat: #5, #6, #7, #15. These areas are identified by signage and will be deemed "No Access" for play or ball retrieval. You must drop a ball keeping the spot where the ball last crossed the margin of the "Natural Habitat" area and the course between you and the hole. You may go as far back as you like or you may replay your shot from the original location. In the case of #7 you may also proceed to the drop area. Players found entering these areas will forfeit their green fee.

Drop Area: #11 when your ball fails to reach the green safely, under penalty of one stroke, please proceed to the drop area to play the next shot. **# 19** when your ball is at rest in the "Natural Habitat" area, under penalty of one stroke, please proceed to the "Drop Area" to play the next shot.

Please utilize the divot mix located on every power cart, rake bunkers, and repair all ball marks on greens.

Pace of Play

In the interest of all players, please adhere to our 4 hour and 30 minute pace of play policy. Bear Mountain player assistants reserve the right to direct you to pick up your ball and proceed to the next teeing ground if your group falls behind one complete hole.

Cell Phones

Permitted on the course with the understanding that all ring settings will be adjusted to vibrate. In courtesy to other players please restrict to incoming calls only and do not delay play.

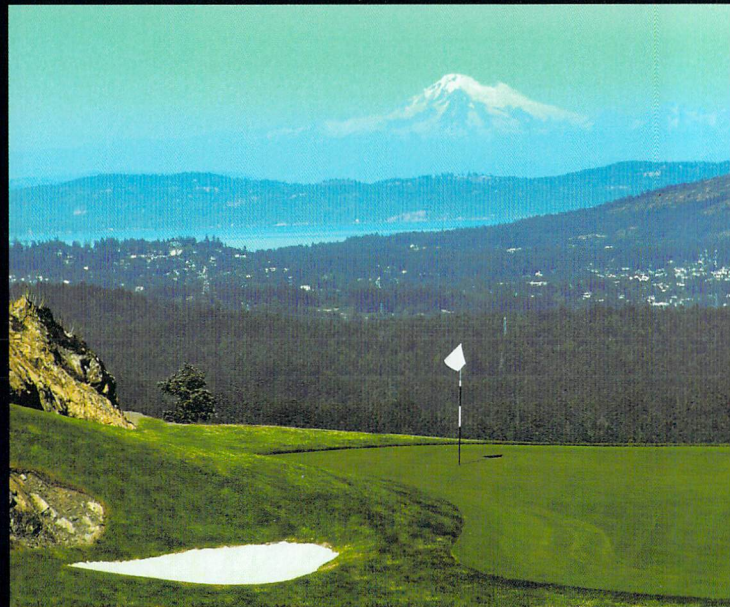

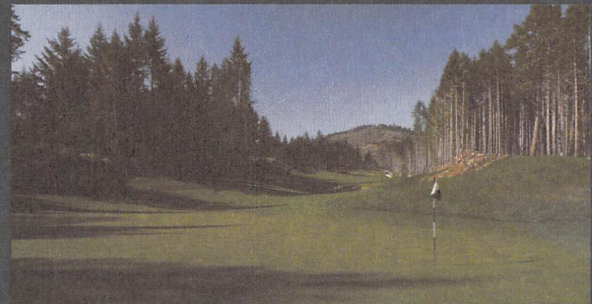
