

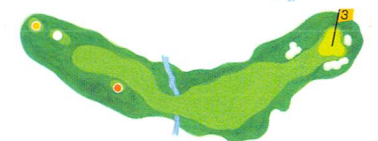
1 Don't be fooled by this seemingly relaxed first hole. Aim for the center of the fairway with driver, three wood or long iron. Mid to short iron into large green that doesn't give putts away easily.
Green depth 35 yds



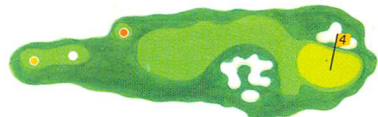
2 Tee shot critical on this the longest par 4 at Golden. Long iron or wood second shot requiring accuracy to this long, narrow green.
Green depth 40 yds



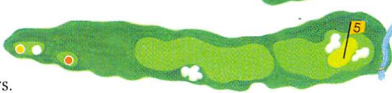
3 Dogleg left par 4 requires a tee shot that carries the small creek, crossing the fairway. Mid to short iron needed to reach the green.
Green depth 29 yds



4 Tough par 3 requires tee shot to carry entire distance to green. Large green sloping right to left can be tricky putting.
Green depth 43 yds



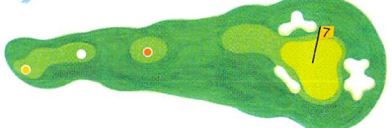
5 Best approach on this mid length par 4 is right centre of fairway. Careful on the green, the subtle undulations will frustrate the best of putters.
Green depth 32 yds



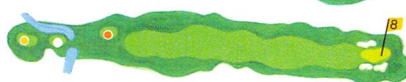
6 This 5 par is best played in three shots. A well placed tee shot left of centre will open up the dogleg for an easier fairway wood second shot. Your third shot sets up birdie opportunities for good short iron players.
Green depth 40 yds



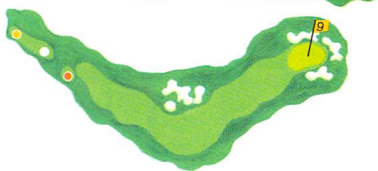
7 This short par 3 plays tougher than it appears. Don't be short off the tee. Green slopes severely from left to right.
Green depth 32 yds



8 Straightaway par 5 reachable in two for long hitters. Green is at least three clubs long and well bunkered.
Green depth 46 yds

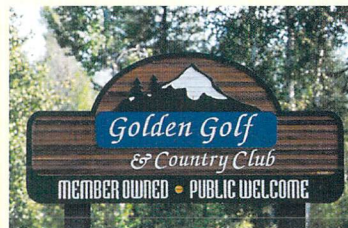


9 Long hitters may cut corner over bunkers to set up short second shot. Never any trouble in the centre of the fairway though!
Green depth 36 yds

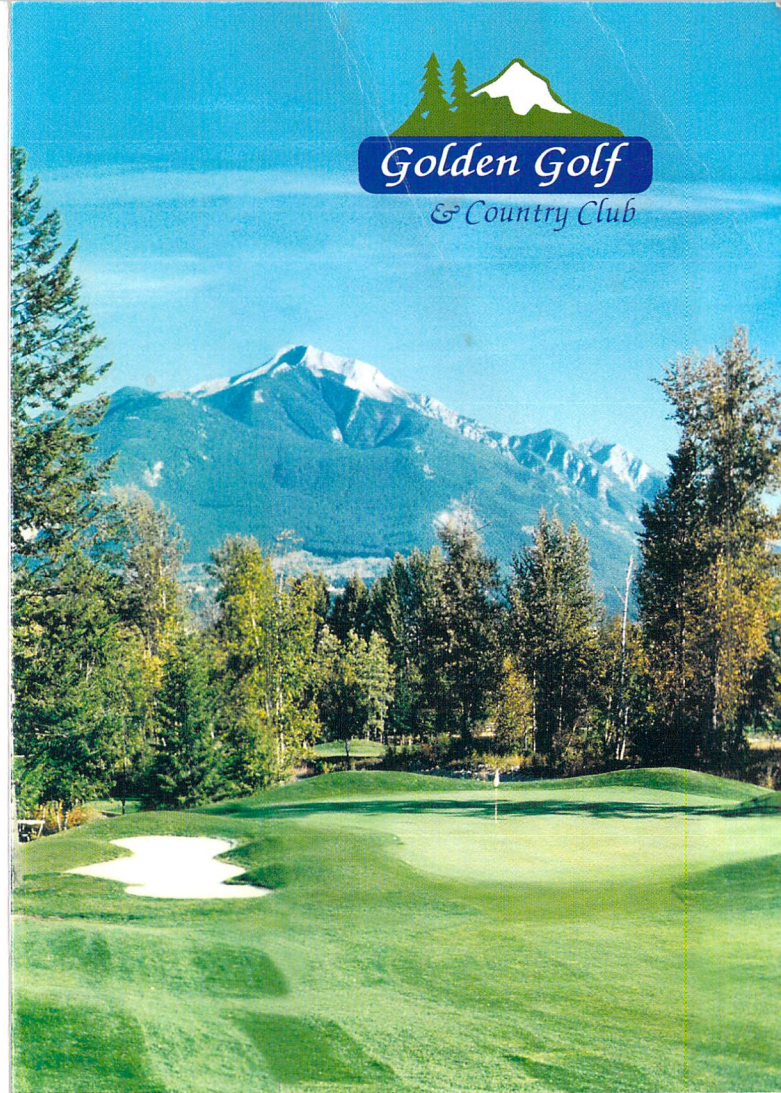
