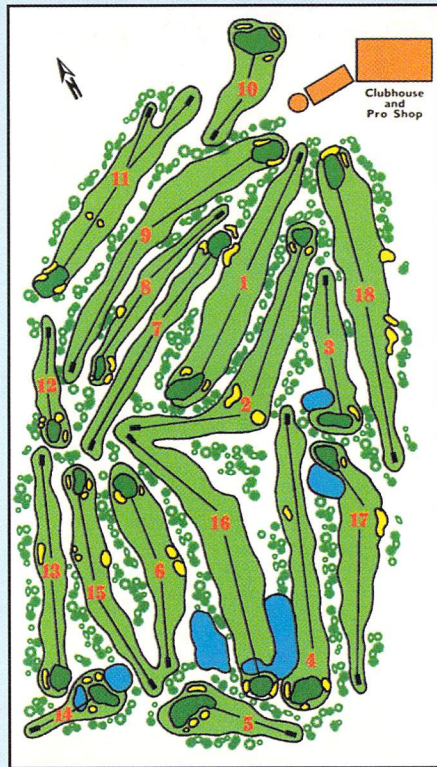

Rules of the ROYAL CANADIAN GOLF ASSOCIATION will govern all play except where modified by local rules.

LOCAL RULES

Immovable Obstructions (rule 24-2) Free drop all logs, outhouses, pump-houses, sprinkler control boxes, sprinkler heads—relief grants one club length, closest relief from condition no nearer hold, only when interfering with stance or swing.

Out of Bounds, Fences and Lines: No relief except under the rules of golf. The nearest inside points at ground level delineate out of bounds. If line drawn—the line itself is out of bounds.

Driving Range: Out of bounds.

Water Hazards: Yellow Stakes: (Rule 26) The water in front of #3, #14, #16 and #17 are water hazards - relief may be taken under the rules of golf or the drop areas may be used when designated.

Integral Part of golf Course: When playing #7, where player's swing, stance or line of sight are interfered with by the fence alongside #7 green, a player may elect to drop his/her ball in the drop area provided under the rules of golf.

Roadways and Pathways: All active service roads and pathways within the boundaries of the golf course are considered dangerous and relief without penalty may be taken—one club length, no nearer the hole—closest relief.

Ground Under Repair: Delineated by white line. Relief without penalty—one club length, no nearer the hole—closest point of relief must be taken. N.B.: All flower beds within bounds of course.

Practice Putting Greens: This is a wrong green under the rules of golf (Rule 25-3). Hit when ready. Have fun.

Bunkers: Rocks may be removed from bunkers.
