R 324



Difficult starting hole requires a tee shot up the right centre avoiding the O.B. left. Take an extra club on the approach. Have your short game ready.



W 103
R 96



Short par 3 requires a solid short iron from the tee to avoid the bunker short. Shots hit beyond the green leave a tough chip coming back.



W 277
R 262



Enjoy the view before attempting to reach this short par 4 from the tee. The green slopes front to back requiring a precise touch on your approach.



W 326
R 313



Favour the left side from the tee in order to open up the green for your 2nd shot. The approach requires good distance control. Par is always a great score.



W 295
R 282



Favour the left side from the tee on this short Par 4. The open green will allow for an excellent birdie opportunity.



W 484
R 402



Short but tricky Par 5 should not be taken lightly as O.B. flanks both sides of the fairway. A drive down the left centre to the corner can set up a chance to reach in 2.



W 181
R 176



This tough Par 3 requires an extra club to reach the green. Try to leave your tee shot right of the hole to avoid rolling off this sloping green.



W 125
R 110



Favour the right side of the green to avoid the deep grass bunker on the left of this short Par 3. A nice tee shot can leave you with a very good birdie chance.



W 400
R 391



This long downhill, dogleg Par 4 requires a right to left tee shot. The approach requires less club than normal. Being long leaves a very difficult chip coming back.

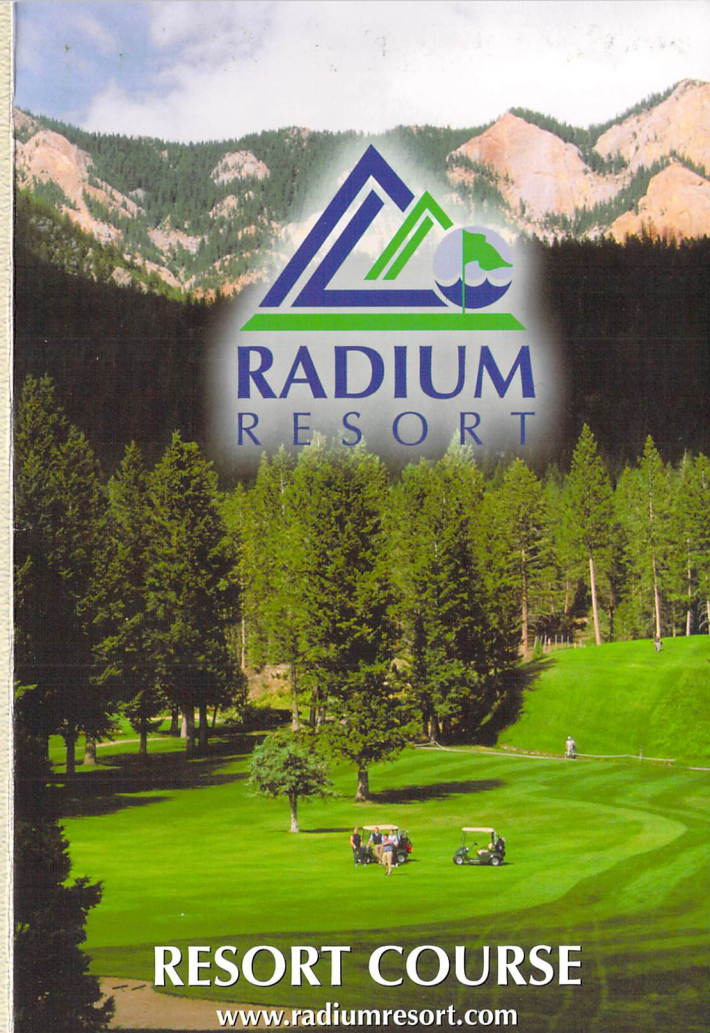

R 311



Accuracy is the key all the way up on this short but very intimidating Par 4. An iron or fairway wood tee shot sets up an approach to a very small green.

W 308
R 279



An accurate iron or fairway wood tee shot is recommended in order to avoid the O.B. right and trees left. An excellent birdie opportunity.

W 160
R 145



This spectacular Par 3 requires precise distance control from the tee. The 100' drop from tee to green requires one or two less clubs than usual. Bring your camera!!

W 375
R 350



Accurate tee shot is required in order to avoid the O.B. right, setting up the approach to this elevated two-tier green. Favour the left side all the way.

14
W 489
R 423



Let the driver fly on this Par 5, the longest hole on the course. Big hitters can reach in two but be careful as the fairway narrows tightly near this large green.

15
W 188
R 177



Longest Par 3 on the course requires an accurate tee shot to avoid the bunker left and trouble right. Shots left short of the green still leave a good chance for par.

W 448
R 401



A left to right tee shot is ideal on this short par 5, giving big hitters a chance to reach in two. Stay below the hole if you can on this tough multi-tiered green.

W 126
R 105



Don't let the yardage fool you here. Precise distance control is required to avoid the pond fronting this narrow elevated green. Par is an excellent score.

W 362
R 350



Beautiful downhill finishing hole. Please be sure the group ahead is out of range before teeing off. Approach over water to this two tiered green requires excellent distance control.

- Local Rules**
- Rules of the RCGA govern all play except where local rules apply.
 - Out of Bounds is defined by white stakes and all boundary fences. The white stakes between holes #5 and #6 apply to hole #6 only. There is no O.B. on hole #5. Concrete behind #9 green and tennis courts behind #14 green are also O.B.
 - Flowerbeds, water valves, ground boxes and gravel area behind #10 green are immovable obstructions.
