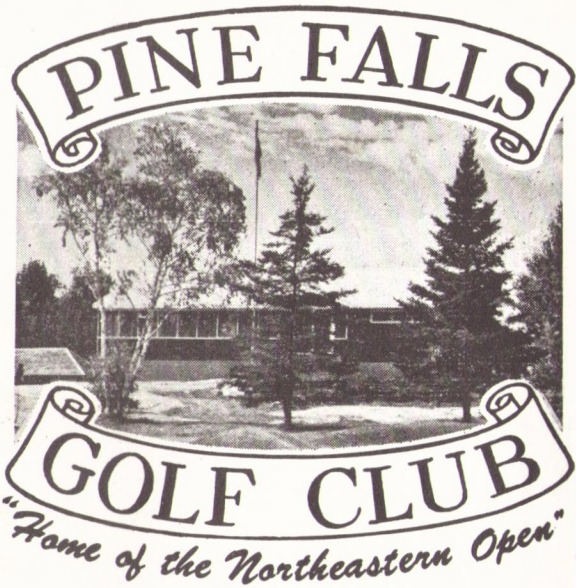

## LOCAL RULES

## GENERAL

(A) For the purpose of interpretation, only the normal watercourse or channel of the creek crossing No. 1 and No. 9 fairways constitute a water hazard. Not the banks.

(B) There will be no free lifts from any ditches other than those designated in these Local Rules.

OUT OF BOUNDS—All fences—Penalty: stroke and distance.

HOLE No. 5—A ball in that portion of the ditch crossing fairway opposite No. 6 Tee may be lifted and dropped not nearer hole without penalty.

HOLE No. 6—A ball in ditches in front of and to right of green may be lifted and dropped not nearer hole without penalty.

HOLE No. 9—A ball coming to rest to the left of the driving markers on No. 1 fairway and east of the creek, must be played from where it lies with a penalty of one stroke.

A ball in ditches on either side of fairway may be lifted without penalty and dropped a distance of two club lengths but not nearer hole.
