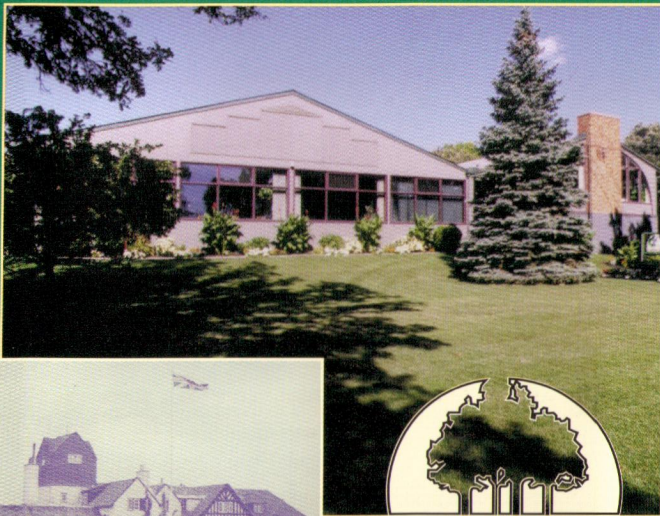


SOUTHWOOD GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB



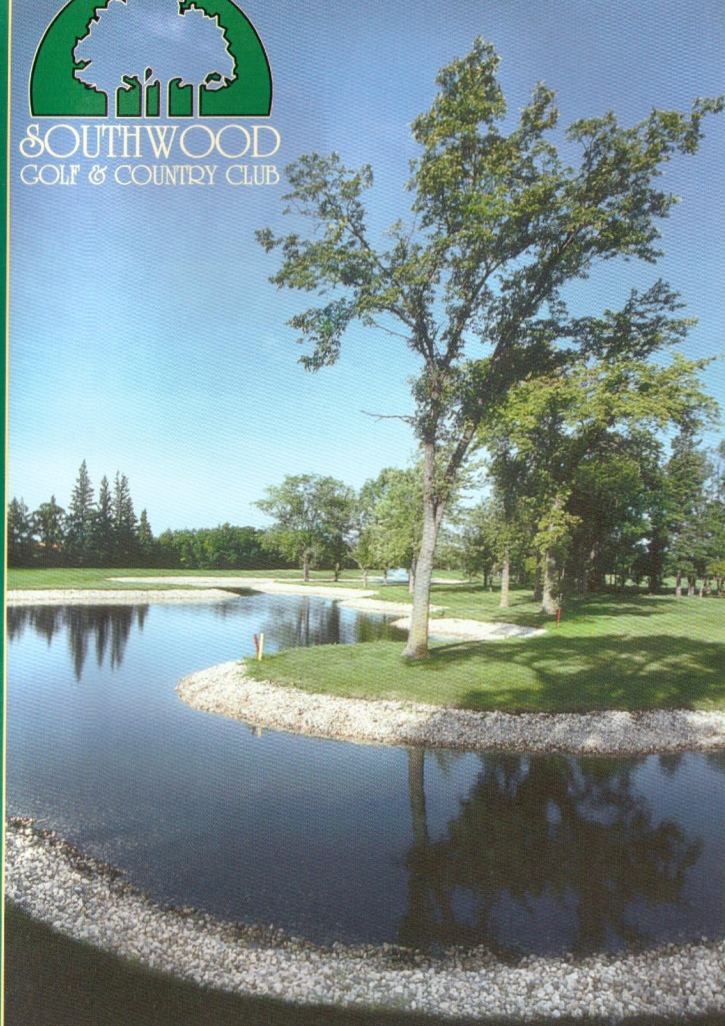
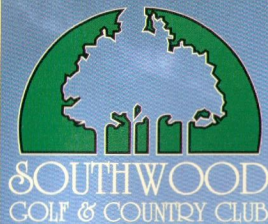
Southwood is a private club located hard by the University of Manitoba campus in South Suburban Winnipeg. Southwood celebrated it's 75th anniversary in 1998, having first opened in 1923. The original property was home to the Winnipeg Hunt Club.

The original course was laid out by Willie Park Jr. with recent renovations completed by Bob Moote of Toronto and local architects David Wagner and David Grant.

Southwood is a wonderful combination of length and strategic designs, challenging both the scratch player and the enthusiast. Tree-lined fairways put the premium on accuracy from the tee and water hazard positions force the player to make careful decisions. The course's strength lies in its first six holes and towards the finishing holes fifteen through seventeen. The ninth, tenth and eleventh holes play beside the banks of the Red River and the club offers a beautiful vista of this local waterway.

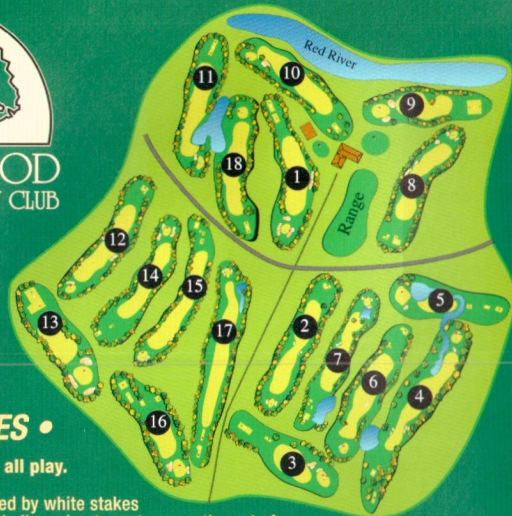
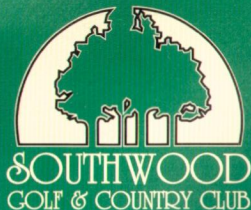

• LOCAL RULES •

• R.C.G.A. Rules govern all play.

• **Out of Bounds:** Defined by white stakes and boundary fences. A ball coming to rest across the out of bounds markers is considered out of bounds even if it rests on part of the course. The driving range and parking lot are also out of bounds. The range fence and its supports are an obstruction on the 8th hole.

• **Water Hazards:** Defined by yellow stakes.

• **Lateral Water Hazards:** Defined by red stakes. The bank of the Red River running along the 9th and 10th fairways is a lateral water hazard.

• **Relief Without Penalty:** From all ribboned trees, cultivated hedges, flower gardens, green nurseries on 11th and 18th holes. Fences protecting tees on holes 1, 6, 9 10 and 17 are considered obstructions. Relief is free stance and swing plus one club length, note closer to the hole. Relief without penalty is also provided if ball lies on or stance/swing are impeded by stone drains through the green, or area marked with white paint (ground under repair).

• **Severe Weather Procedure:** In the threat of injury from lightning or other severe weather, the signal to stop play is one long blast of an air horn, repeated. Players are advised to seek shelter immediately. The signal for resumption of play will be three short blasts of an air horn.
