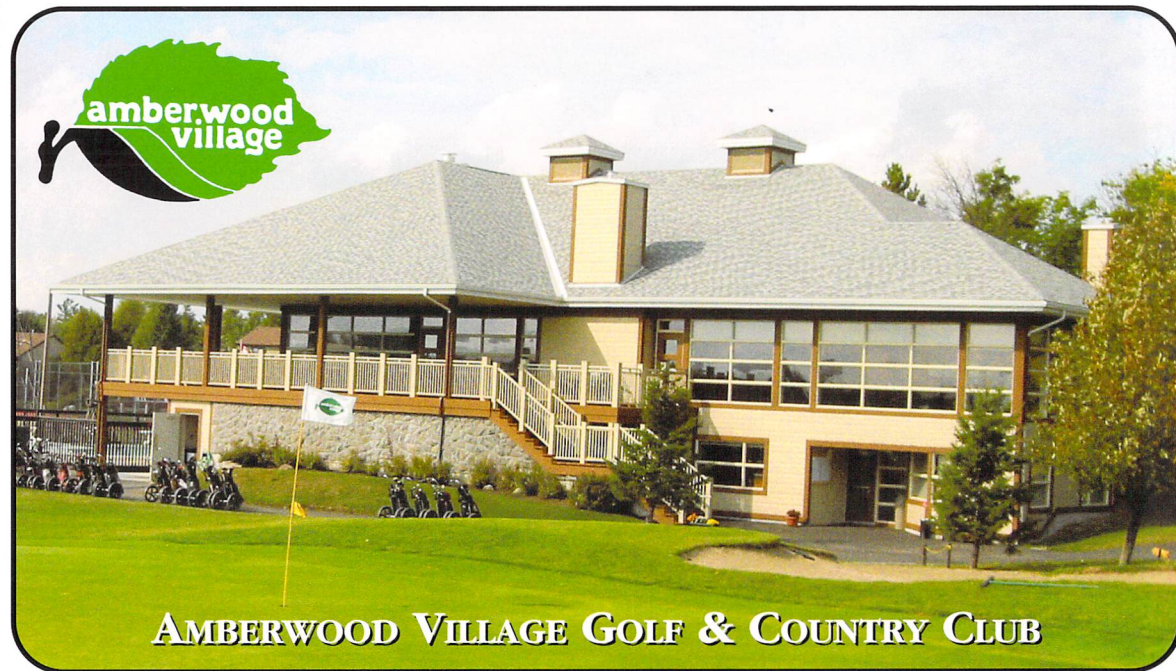

### ALL PLAY IS GOVERNED BY RCGA RULES AND INCLUDES:

1. If a ball stops within a flower bed or the flower bed interferes with a player's stance, or if a tree marked with a ribbon or a stake interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball may be lifted without penalty and dropped as per R. 24-2b (i) i.e. determine the nearest point of relief, then drop the ball within one club length (both not nearer the hole).
2. Except as noted under Rule 3, a ball resting on a maintenance road or cart path – relief is permitted as per R. 24-2b (i).
3. There is no relief without penalty from crossings (bridges, pathways) within the water hazards (R. 24-2). Club may be grounded (R. 13-4), ball may be played without penalty from position on crossing; or you may proceed, with penalty of one stroke, under the water hazard rule (R. 26-1).
4. No. 8 Hole - The area of #9 Hole from the maintenance pathway through to the green is Out of Bounds when playing #8 Hole.
5. Third party damage to homes adjacent to golf course is the player's responsibility.

WHITE STAKES / LINES indicate out of bounds. YELLOW STAKES indicate water hazard.

RED STAKES indicate lateral water hazard.

Replace divots, repair ball marks on greens, rake bunkers (leave rake in bunker).
