THE RULES OF PLAY

Royal Canadian Golf Association rules govern all play, except as amended by the following local rules.

- French Drains and Gardens are considered to be ground under repair. Relief - closest ground that affords relief plus one club length, not nearer to the hole. (See Rule 25-1)
- Areas through the green that are covered in wood chips are in play. No relief.

PLEASE

Keep power carts on paths, where provided, and at least 30 feet from greens and tees.

Power caddies must be kept away from tees, greens and fringes.
