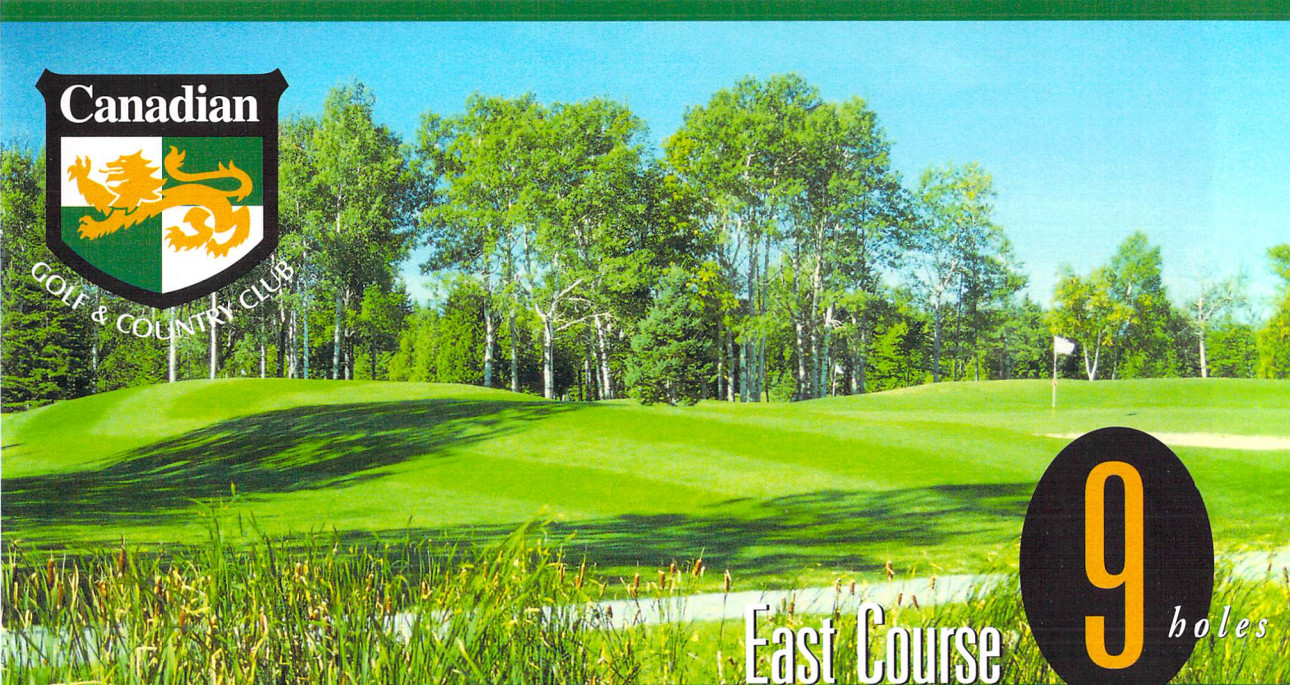

**R.C.G.A. OR C.L.G.A. RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES**

**Local Rules**

- All Golf Carts must remain on cart paths around Tees and Greens - no exceptions. Directional signs and ropes must be obeyed.
- Around tees all pull carts must be kept on paths. Pull carts must not be pulled across tees or on sides of tees.
- Around greens pull carts must be kept a minimum of **30 feet away** from **putting** surface.
- Playing time for 18 holes is **4-4 1/2 hours** or 13 to 15 minutes / hole. Please observe this time frame. Faster players behind must be allowed to play through. Groups that cannot keep pace may be moved ahead on course or removed.
- Out of bounds** is defined by white stakes and fences. **Penalty:** Stroke and distance.
- Obstructions:** All cartpaths and roadways are obstructions. Sprinkler heads and valve boxes are also obstructions **Relief:** one club length, not nearer the hole - no penalty.
- All lakes and ditches are defined as water hazards.  
**Water Hazards:** Yellow stakes      **Lateral Water Hazards:** Red stakes.
- Ground Under Repair** is marked as such by rope, sign or white painted line. Relief: one club length, not nearer the hole - no penalty
- Dress Code:** proper dress required.

**HELP STAMP OUT SLOW PLAY**

- Pace of play is maintained by remaining 'Directly Behind the Group Ahead' not just by remaining 'Directly Ahead of the Group Behind'
- Continuous putting recommended whenever possible
