All distances are to the middle of the green.

R.C.G.A. RULES GOVERN PLAY EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS – boundaries are defined by white stakes, or fence lines. Red stakes define lateral water hazard. Yellow stakes define water hazard.
2. HOLE NO. 2 – BLACK FENCE RIGHT OF GREEN – ball coming to rest in bounds may be dropped, without penalty, within 1 club length no nearer the hole which affords swing and stance relief.
3. HOLE NO. 8 – a) tee shot only – ball coming to rest beyond and to the right of imaginary line between the last white stake behind 7th tee and the white stake on left side of the 8th fairway is out of bounds.
b) the 7th hole is a protective out of bounds defined by white stakes on any shot played.
4. Water outlets, other immovable club equipment, staked trees and trees less than one club length in height and pathways, interfering with player's stance or swing, ball shall be lifted and dropped within one club length of the nearest point which affords relief not nearer the hole.
