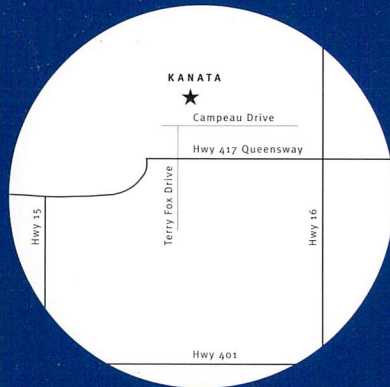

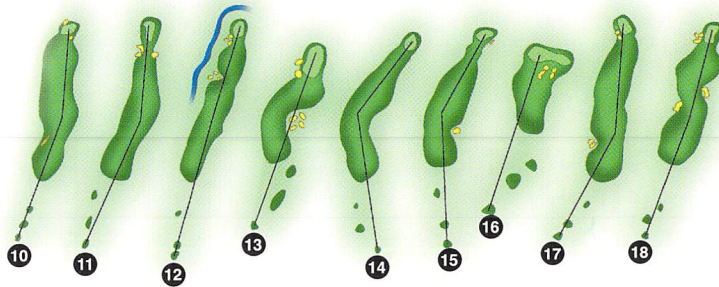
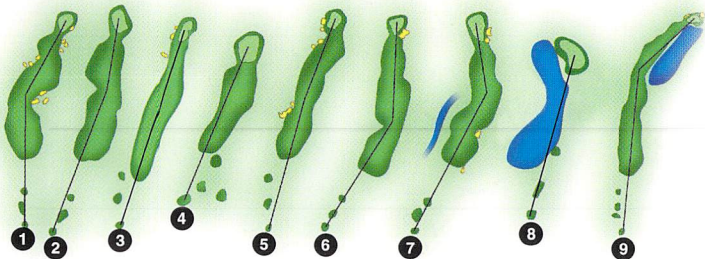

PACE OF PLAY

To improve 'pace of play', ClubLink has implemented a "Flag System". Our Play Coordinators have been authorized to use this method to keep your group 'in position' throughout the round. As the Play Coordinator routinely approaches your group, he/she will display one of three flags to identify your position and pace.

- ▶ Green Flag: Your group is 'in position' relative to your start time and/or groups ahead. Keep playing at your current pace.
- ▶ Yellow Flag: Your group has fallen 'out of position' relative to your start time and/or the groups ahead. Please improve your pace immediately to re-establish proper position.
- ▶ Red Flag: Your group has fallen severely 'out of position'. The Play Coordinator will now assist the group to re-establish proper 'position'. Your group may be asked to 'pick-up' and move ahead to the appropriate position or allow faster groups to 'play through'. Thank you for your cooperation.

LOCAL RULES

RCGA Rules Govern All Play

- Water Hazards - Defined by Yellow Stakes
- Lateral Hazards - Defined by Red Stakes
- Out of Bounds - Defined by White Stakes and Boundary Fences
- French drains and drainage ditches - Free Lift

Please... rake tracks in bunkers, keep carts on path wherever possible near tees and greens, fill divots with provided sand, repair ball marks on greens, wear proper golf attire. Thanks... and good golfing!

PIN POSITIONS

Front - Red Middle - White Back - Blue
Yardage measured to centre of green

WARNING: LIGHTNING POSES A SERIOUS RISK TO GOLFERS

When you suspect that there may be lightning or hear one long horn blast indicating the possibility of lightning, please seek the clubhouse, on-course buildings and automobiles. When none of the above are available, look for dense woods and low-lying areas. **Avoid...** Open areas, water, metal, wire fences, powerlines, overhead wires, isolated trees, elevated ground, maintenance machinery and golf carts. Raising umbrellas above the head increases the risk when lightning is near. Three short horn blasts indicate it is safe to return on the field. The Golf Shop will endeavor to warn you of lightning. However, ClubLink is not held responsible for removing Members and guests from the golf course.
