LAKWOOD GOLF CLUB SCORE CARD RULES

All play governed by R.C.G.A. rules of golf and the following local rules:

- 1) Preferred lies on your own fairway. Move ball no more than one club length, no closer to hole. Play the ball as it lies anywhere else.
- 2) Out of Bounds—white stakes on No. 7, No. 9, No. 18, and fence on No. 6, No. 7, No. 10, No. 11, No. 14 and No. 15. NOTE: Boundary is determined by line joining nearest inside points of fence posts or stakes at ground level. (NOTE: No relief from boundary stakes, fence, or cement foundations of fence posts).
- 3) All ponds and North-South ditches are lateral water hazards; except, ditches on No. 8 and No. 18 are regular water hazards, as well as any water hazard wherein entry is made between yellow stakes. East-West ditch running from No. 8 green toward No. 1 fairway is a regular water hazard. Any other ditch-like depressions on the course are not hazards.
- 4) Plugged ball rule in effect through the green (ball must be resting in its own plug mark). Lift, clean and drop no more than one club length from original position, no closer to hole; no penalty.

ETIQUETTE AND OTHER REGULATIONS:

- 1) Golf course is not open for play when Pro Shop is closed.
- 2) All players must register in Pro Shop before using any part of the course.
- 3) Everyone must be properly clothed including footwear, at all times. Cut-offs, abbreviated or slovenly attire of any type will NOT be allowed. Please keep your shirt on.
- 4) Do not start play at 10th tee unless given permission by Pro Shop attendant.
- 5) The starter or ranger has authority to create foursomes when necessary.
- 6) Green fee players must retain their receipts, as they may be required to produce them at any time.
- 7) Please replace turf, rake sand traps, fix ball marks on greens, and do not litter.
- 8) NO practising on regular course or greens.
- 9) Four ball play is maximum allowed (no fivesomes, etc.).
- 10) Matches taking more than five minutes between nines for refreshments, etc., must allow following groups to play through at 10th tee.
- 11) At any time, if the hole ahead is clear, allow faster players behind to play through. Wait until they are out of range before resuming play.
- 12) Keep all automotive golf cars in the rough and at least 30 feet away from all tees and greens. Only two riders per golf car. Juniors (under 18 years) are not allowed to drive or rent cars.
- 13) Ontario law prohibits alcoholic beverages on the golf course, or outside the clubhouse licenced areas.
