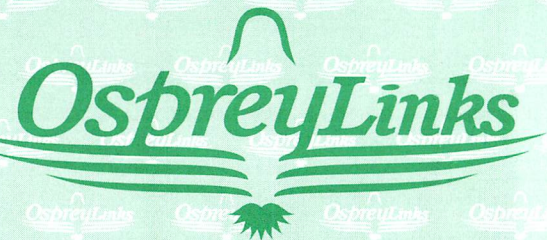

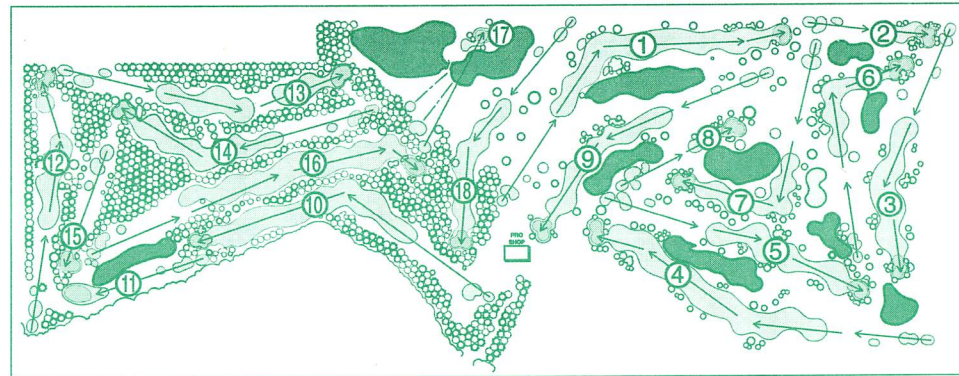

LOCAL RULES

Rules of the RCGA govern all play, except as modified by the local club rules.

One club length relief without improving course position from trees supported by wires and stakes, and trees less than one club length tall. Boundaries are defined by white stakes or fences bordering club property or painted white lines. Ground under repair is any area defined by white paint, french drains and cultivated beds for flowers or shrubbery. Out-of-Bounds are defined by white stakes or lines. Lateral water hazards are defined by yellow stakes or lines. Water hazards are defined by red stakes or lines. All players must have their own set of clubs.

REPLACE DIVOTS ♦ RAKE BUNKERS ♦ REPAIR BALL MARKS

All carts, Power, Electronic or Pull must be kept away from the greens and outside the white painted lines. Where cart paths are located, carts must be kept on the paths.
